No Seed will be shipped until contract is approved and in place with Perdue.

In the past, we have not accepted Plenish beans over 14% moisture to be delivered at harvest. Understanding concerns many of you have expressed about this, we made some changes beginning for the Fall 2015 program.

If you want to harvest beans over 14% moisture, we will accept them at the Salisbury Grain terminal using our normal discount schedule at time of harvest. If you have Plenish® beans contracted at one of our other locations and want to deliver them at harvest with over 14% moisture, you will have the option to deliver the load to Salisbury so that you still receive the premium. We also will pay you the basis difference between your contracted location and Salisbury day of delivery. As our Plenish® High Oleic program grows in the future, we will expand moisture programs to additional locations. We hope this will offer some of you more flexibility.
