GENERAL CONTRACT TERMS

Grower must be a certified organic grower and all organic growing practices must be observed. Growers will be required to submit a current copy of their organic certification prior to a contract being generated. Please note that some of our organic oilseed crops, sunflowers and canola, require that they be raised with Canadian equivalent organic practices, meaning no use of Chilean nitrate or sodium nitrate.

Perdue offers two ways you can contract your organic crops. You can either agree to sell us your entire production of a crop and have an acre contract, this eliminates the worry about how many bushels you will have in yield, or you can lock in a price and sell a certain number of bushels or truckloads. Our program allows you to decide which type of contract works best for you.



Organic contracts must be signed and returned before delivery paperwork can be issued.

PRICING AND PAYMENT

Organic wheat, corn, soybean, and high oleic soybean pricing are determined by bid pricing which can change periodically based on market conditions. Prices are for delivery to one of our receiving facilities and can vary by delivery location. Organic sunflower and canola pricing are normally established at the beginning of the season and are a fixed price. Contact your Perdue representative for price quotes.

Perdue offers direct deposit which helps expedite your receipt of payments. Growers also may choose to receive a check that will be mailed to them once their shipments are settled.

Perdue has receiving locations for our organic crops at our organic certified elevators, as well as our processing plants and feed mills. In the Southeast, our receiving points are Greenville, NC for organic wheat, organic corn, and organic high oleic soybeans. Pantego, NC is our receiving plant for organic soybeans. Organic sunflowers and canola are normally picked up from the grower's farm.

Growers may deliver their crop to the Perdue designated delivery point or Perdue will pick up the crop from grower's farm and deduct freight costs from the quoted payment rate. If a grower uses his trucking, proper cleanout of trucks to ensure organic integrity will be required. Please note that belt trailers may not be used for deliveries.

To minimize freight costs, Perdue attempts to purchase full truckloads. Should a grower wish to ship a partial truckload, any dead freight will be at the grower's expense.
