300+ acres - \$1.00/CWT 700+ acres - \$3.00/CWT

GROWER REFERRAL PREMIUM:

HEAR grower providing the referral of a new HEAR grower will receive \$500 dollars. A check will be issued after referral grower seed purchase.

SUSTAINABILITY OFFER:

Eligible for participation in the Perdue Sustainability Program (incentives up to \$45/acre).

Enrolling in the Sustainability Analysis is the first step to getting paid for implementing regenerative practices on your farm. This analysis requires no practice changes - you will earn \$1/acre simply for sharing data about your current management practices.

WHY GROW

HEAR



- Offers a higher revenue opportunity to winter wheat.
- Extends rotations, providing an additional cropping option.
- Crop diversification breaks weed and pest cycles.
- Has beneficial tap root -drought tolerant, improves soil tilth.
- Crop following high erucic acid rapeseed often have experience higher yields resulting from residual fertilization.
- Easier plant back than winter wheat, less residue, less "hair-pinning."

OUR CONTRACTS REDUCE GROWER RISK

- Acre Contracts: Farmers contract for actual production on the acreage that they plant (not bushels).
- Fixed Price Contracts: Know what you will be paid upfront.
- Standard Crop Loss Protection Clause: On all rapeseed contracts to reduce farmer risk.
- Full Production Purchase Guarantee: We purchase as little or as much as you produce.
- No Speculation: We have contracts with our end use customers before offering grower contracts.
- Crop Insurance Availability: Check with your local Crop Insurance Office.
- Equipment Incentive of \$.05/Bu or \$.10/CWT to support Best Management Practices that support increases in HEAR production are available.

PRODUCTION GUIDELINES

PLANTING:

Sept. 1 - Oct. 15 on well drained soils; regionally dependent

SEEDBED PREP:

Conventional Tillage Min Tillage No Tillage

SEEDING RATE:

2.5 - 3.5 lbs. per acre 6-8 plants per sq. ft. in late fall

ROW SPACING:

7.5" - 15"

SEEDING DEPTH:

1/2" - 3/4"

WEED CONTROL:

Rapeseed is aggressive against most winter broadleaves. Fields with severe Italian ryegrass or wild mustard/radish should be avoided.

FERTILITY:

Nitrogen 150# per acre; Sulfur 25-30#; and Boron 1-2# required where deficiencies exist. Nitrogen spring applied prior to stem extension per tissue sample. Additional nutrient availability: P = 80lbs, K=120lbs Adjusted per soil test.

INSECT MANAGEMENT:

Fall insects generally controlled by beneficials; spring insects such as aphids or seed podweevils treated per scouting thresholds.

FUNGAL DISEASE MANAGEMENT:

Fungicides may be necessary at early bloom for Sclerotinia and Alternaria fungi.

HARVEST:

Early-Mid June

YIELD GOAL: 40-65 bu./ac

(management and weather dependent)
