Deliver grain to a Perdue[®] eligible grain processor in DE, MD, VA, PA, NJ or NC by June 30, 2026 (refer to the list below).

PRACTICES²

No-till, strip-till, and/or cover crop practices were used in the 2025 crop year and will be continued for at least 10 more years.

DATA

Agree to submit agronomic data for the 2025 crop year (only one year of agronomic data is required).
